

Hayley Fein is an all-region pick for the second consecutive season

SEASIDE, **Calif.** — Sophomore pitcher/designated player <u>Hayley Fein</u> (Sparks, Nev./Spanish Springs HS) put a cap on the 2018 Cal State Monterey Bay softball season by earning all–region honors from the Conference Commissioners Association. Fein, who was a first team All–California Collegiate Athletic Association pick for the second consecutive season, also earns her second all–region nod in as many seasons.

Fein once again led the Otter pitching staff in virtually every meaningful category. She finished the season 17–15 in the circle with 108 strikeouts and a 2.76 ERA. She also led the team with five shutouts, two saves and a .243 opponent batting average.

At the plate, where she saw her first regular action as a collegiate hitter, Fein hit .277 with seven doubles, a triple and three home runs, including a grand slam. She finished the season with a slash line of .277/.415/.336.

In the CSUMB record book, Fein joins <u>Cori Reinhardt</u> as the only Otter pitchers ever to win 17 or more games in a season twice as an Otter. She joins <u>Jessica Boyle</u> and <u>Lindsey Clarkson</u> as the only Otters to strike out 108 or more batters in a season twice.

She will begin her junior season ranked No. 4 on the Otter career list for victories with 46 and No. 2 in career saves with four and No. 4 in career shutouts with 14. Her 253 strikeouts also rank No. 4 on the Otter career list as well.
